

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-154

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE EXPENDITURE IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$17,083.84 FOR A ONE (1) YEAR PERIOD FROM THE LAW ENFORCEMENT TRUST FUND-*STATE* TO THE MIAMI-DADE COUNTY ASSOCIATION OF CHIEFS OF POLICE, COUNTY COURT STANDBY PROGRAM, UPON SUCH COSTS HAVING BEEN APPROVED BY THE CHIEF OF POLICE, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Miami-Dade County Association of Chiefs of Police and the Miami-Dade County State Attorney's Office have implemented the Court Standby Program which employs administrative support personnel to notify crime victims, witnesses, and officers when they are required to appear in criminal court, thereby reducing the number of times a sworn officer makes a court appearance to find that either the victim or the witnesses are absent and the proceeding is continued; and

WHEREAS, since implementation of the Court Standby Program, this system has greatly reduced the costs of overtime for court appearances for the Hialeah Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the agency members of the Miami-Dade County Association of Chiefs of Police are billed based on the proportional utilization of services from the participating law enforcement agencies as determined by the number of traffic, domestic violence, and misdemeanor cases processed through the Miami-Dade County State Attorney's Office at the courthouse; and

WHEREAS, the Hialeah Police Department's proportional share of expenses for its inclusion in the Court Standby Program for a one (1) year period is \$17,083.84; and

WHEREAS, the requested funding will assist with operational costs of the Court Standby Program;

WHEREAS, Miami-Dade County Association of Chiefs of Police is an active corporation in good standing in the state of Florida; and

WHEREAS, funding for this project will be from account 105.1000.521.640 Law Enforcement Trust Fund-*State*; and

WHEREAS, Section 932.7055, Fla. Stat. (2018), the Florida Contraband and Forfeiture Act, authorizes the expenditure of Law Enforcement Trust Funds-*State* for this purpose and the

funds are available in the Law Enforcement Trust Fund-*State* account for the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police of the Hialeah Police Department has recommended adoption of this resolution and determined that the proposed expenditure complies with the Florida Contraband Forfeiture Act, and all applicable rules, regulations and guidelines governing the expenditure of Law Enforcement Trust Fund-*State*; and

WHEREAS, the City finds the expenditure is in the public interest;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1: The foregoing facts and recitations contained in the preamble to this resolution are hereby adopted and incorporated by reference as if fully set forth herein.


Section 2: The City of Hialeah, Florida hereby approves the expenditure of an amount not exceeding \$17,083.84 from the Law Enforcement Trust Fund-*State* account to the Miami-Dade County Association of Chiefs of Police for the Hialeah Police Department’s participation in the Court Standby Program for a one (1) year period, upon such costs having been approved by the Chief of Police of the Hialeah Police Department having specifications and pursuant to the terms and conditions as set forth in “Exhibit 1.”


Section 3: This resolution shall become effective when passed by the City Council and signed by the Mayor.




Dear Chief of Police

This invoice represents your prorated share of the operating expenses for the Court Standby Program for FY20/21 which begins on October 1, 2020. Each agency is invoiced based on their corresponding number of traffic, domestic violence, and misdemeanor 2019 court cases processed through the State Attorney Office's at the main court house (please see attached report). The annual budget is set at \$496,518. The program cost increased by \$23,320 from the previous year due to changes in fringe benefits percentage and contractual wage increase. Individual invoices may have increased or decreased significantly from the prior year due to changes in agency enforcement activity during 2019 and any change in program cost.

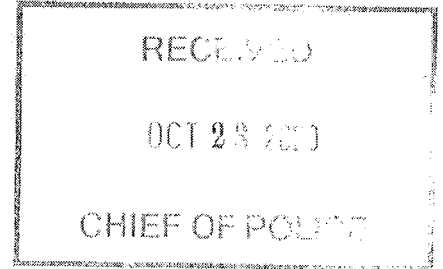

Dear Mayor Hernandez and Council Members:





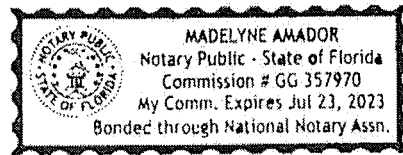
