RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, TO ACCEPT A REIMBURSEMENT AWARD OF CARES ACT FUNDING PASSED THROUGH FROM MIAMI DADE COUNTY, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,000,000.00, TO PROVIDE ASSISTANCE WITH BUSINESS RENTAL ASSISTANCE TO ELIGIBLE BUSINESSES OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH WHO HAVE BEEN FINANCIALLY IMPACTED BY THE NOVEL CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19), , FOR A TERM COMMENCING ON NOVEMBER 10, 2020 THROUGH DECEMBER 30, 2020 AND FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE ON BEHALF OF THE CITY TO EXECUTE ALL OTHER NECESSARY DOCUMENTS IN FURTHERANCE THEREOF; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Coronavirus (COVID-19) emergency has caused disruption in Florida's economy leading to high rates of unemployment and business closures; and

WHEREAS, many businesses of the City of Hialeah are in need of assistance with rent payments; and

WHEREAS, Miami Dade County has been awarded funds by the legislature pursuant to, section 601(d) of the Social Security Act, as amended by section 5001 of the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act, Pub. L. No. 116-136, div. A, Title V (Mar. 27, 2020); and

WHEREAS, Miami Dade County has agreed to reimburse the City of Hialeah through Coronavirus Relief Funds award in the amount of \$2,000,000.00 for the purpose of assisting businesses who have been financially impacted by COVID-19 with rent and mortgage payments, as authorized by the CARES Act. "[Exhibit 1"]

WHEREAS, the City of Hialeah finds it in the best interest of the community to accept the Coronavirus Relief Funds, to assist with business rental assistance to eligible businesses of the City who have suffered loss of income and financial hardship due to this unprecedented health crisis.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1: The foregoing facts and recitations contained in the preamble to this resolution are hereby incorporated and adopted by reference as if fully set forth herein.

Section 2: The Mayor and City Council of the City of Hialeah, Florida hereby approves the acceptance of \$2,000,000.00 to be reimbursed by Miami Dade county, for a term commencing on November 10, 2020 through December 30, 2020, to provide assistance with business rental assistance to eligible of the City of Hialeah who have been financially impacted by the novel Coronavirus (COVID-19).

Section 3: The Mayor or his designee, the Director of the Grants and Human Services Annette Quintana, and the City Clerk, as attesting witness, are hereby authorized, on behalf of the City, to execute all


