RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE EXPENDITURE IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$25,400.00 FROM THE LAW ENFORCEMENT TRUST FUND-FEDERAL FOR THE PURCHASE OF IA PRO INTERNAL AFFAIRS/PROFESSIONAL STANDARDS SOFTWARE AND MAINTENANCE SERVICES FROM CITECHNOLOGIES, INC., AS MORE PARTICULARLY SET FORTH IN THE QUOTE DATED SEPTEMBER 23, 2020, ATTACHED HERETO AND MADE A PART HEREOF AS EXHIBIT "1"; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

- WHEREAS, the Hialeah Police Department seeks to maintain a high level of professionalism and accountability at all levels within the agency; and
- WHEREAS, the Hialeah Police Professional Compliance Bureau is in need of IA Pro Internal Affairs/ Professional Standards Software which will allow proactive approach in complaint management, early intervention, and supervision of personnel; and
- WHEREAS, IA Pro Internal Affairs/ Professional Standards Software is a full-featured software that has been designed specifically to meet the needs of Internal Affairs and Professional Standards Units worldwide; and
- WHEREAS, CI Technologies Inc. is the sole source vendor of IA Pro Internal Affairs/Professional Standards Software; and
- WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 2-817 of the City of Hialeah Code of Ordinances competitive bidding is not needed for sole source vendors; and
- WHEREAS, CI Technologies Inc is an active corporation and in good standing in the State of Florida; and
- **WHEREAS**, Section 932.7055, Fla. Stat. (2018), the Florida Contraband and Forfeiture Act, authorizes the expenditure of Law Enforcement Trust Funds for this purpose and the funds are available in the Law Enforcement Trust Fund-*FEDERAL* account #127.1000.521640 for the Hialeah Police Department; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Chief of Police of the City of Hialeah Police Department has recommended adoption of this resolution and determined that the proposed expenditure complies with the Florida Contraband Forfeiture Act, and all applicable rules, regulations and guidelines governing the expenditure of Law Enforcement Trust Fund-*FEDERAL*; and
 - WHEREAS, the City finds the expenditure is in the public interest.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

<u>Section 1:</u> The foregoing facts and recitations contained in the preamble to this resolution are hereby adopted and incorporated by reference as if fully set forth herein.

Section 2: The City of Hialeah, Florida hereby approves the expenditure of an amount not exceeding \$25,400.00 from the Law Enforcement Trust-Fund-FEDERAL for the purchase of IA Pro Internal Affairs/ Professional Standards Software and maintenance services from CI Technologies, Inc., as more particularly set forth in the quote dated September 23, 2020, attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit "1". Cost of maintenance services for year one is included in the overall rate of \$25,400.00. Maintenance services starting on the second year will be provided at an additional cost of \$4,000.00 per year, subject to appropriation.

Section 3: This resolution shall become effective when approved by majority vote of the City Council and signed by the Mayor or at the next regularly scheduled City Council meeting, if the Mayor's signature is withheld or if the City Council overrides the Mayor's veto.
