

RESOLUTION NO. 2021-002

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, ACCEPTING THE DONATION OF 105 WINN DIXIE SUPERMARKET GIFT CARDS IN AN AMOUNT OF \$250 EACH FOR DISTRIBUTION TO CITY RESIDENTS IMPACTED BY THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, City of Hialeah, Fla. Resolution No. 2020-197 (December 14, 2020) established the Gift Card Program funded with Coronavirus Relief Funds committed to the City by Miami-Dade County pursuant to the Interlocal Agreement between the local government agencies;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Hialeah, Fla. Resolution No. 2020-197, the City purchased a total of 5,000 gift cards in an amount of \$250 each – 3,000 were purchased from Sedano’s Supermarket and 2,000 were purchased from Winn Dixie Supermarket; and

WHEREAS, Winn Dixie Supermarket donated an additional 105 gift cards in an amount of \$250 each to the City to aid in the City’s effort at providing residents with economic relief; and

WHEREAS, it is in the City’s best interest of the health and welfare of the public to accept the 105 Winn Dixie Supermarket gift cards.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1: The City of Hialeah hereby accepts the gift of 105 gift cards in an amount of \$250 each from Winn Dixie to be distributed to City residents impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic.




