

RESOLUTION NO. 2021-016

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, URGING APPROVAL OF THE CITY'S LOCAL FUNDING INITIATIVE BY THE FLORIDA SENATE AND CORRESPONDING APPROPRIATIONS PROJECT REQUEST BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, TO FUND A PROGRAM ADMINISTERED THROUGH THE DEPARTMENT OF ELDER AFFAIRS TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR CONGREGANT AND HOME MEALS THROUGHOUT THE CITY TO THE ELDERLY CITIZENS OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, NUTRITIONAL EDUCATION CLASSES AND SCREENINGS.

WHEREAS, the City of Hialeah is continuously searching for funds as a source of support to provide a daily healthy meal for the elderly in our community and to bolster this effort through nutrition education and screenings; and

WHEREAS, the program funded by the Department of Elder Affairs is expected to yield 300,000 free lunch meals to serve 1,000 elderly City of Hialeah citizens, and provide approximately 9,000 nutrition education classes and 1,000 nutritional screenings for participants; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Elder Affairs administers and funds program services, and initiatives benefiting the elderly; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hialeah finds it is in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the community to fund a program to benefit its elderly.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1: The foregoing facts and reconciliations contained in the preamble to this resolution are hereby incorporated and adopted by reference as it fully set forth herein.

Section 2: The Mayor and the City Council of the City of Hialeah, Florida hereby urge approval of the city's local funding initiative by the Florida Senate and corresponding


appropriations project request by the House of Representatives to fund a program administered through the Department of Elder Affairs for fiscal year 2021-22 to provide funding for congregant and home meals throughout the city to the elderly citizens of the City of Hialeah, nutritional education classes and screenings.




