

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-052

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF HARDWARE, SOFTWARE AND INSTALLATION SERVICES FOR VIGILANT AUTOMATIC LICENSE PLATE READERS, WITH COMMANDCENTRAL AWARE SOFTWARE INTEGRATION FROM MOTOROLA SOLUTIONS, INC. AND CONTRACTING FOR SERVICE AND MAINTENANCE FOR A TERM OF FIVE YEARS, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$488,301.89 FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020, PLUS \$191,658.48 FOR ANNUAL SUBSCRIPTION AND MAINTENANCE SERVICES FOR FISCAL YEARS 2021, 2022, 2023, 2024, FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$679,960.37, BASED ON A COMPETITIVELY BID PRICE AND UPON MATERIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS SUBSTANTIALLY SIMILAR TO BROWARD COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE SOLICITATION BID NO. 19053JLS; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE CITY CLERK, AS ATTESTING WITNESS ON BEHALF OF THE CITY, TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT IN A FORM ACCEPTABLE TO THE CITY ATTORNEY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the coordination of multiple sources of data and information is critical to the effective law enforcement response to crime and dangerous events; and

WHEREAS, translating data that comes from video inputs, incident reports, arrest records, photos, national crime databases, 911 call records, and computer aided dispatch, into actionable intelligence is crucial; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to acquire equipment that will capture and process this information and present it in a single, real-time, operational view, to assist law enforcement; and

WHEREAS, on or about October 23, 2019, Broward County Sheriff's Office ("BSO") issued a Solicitation with Bid No. 19053JLS, to acquire a based layer integrating software platform for BSO's Real Time Crime Center, which included the purchase of hardware, software

and installation services for Vigilant Automatic License Plate Readers, with CommandCentral Aware software integration, among other products and services; and

WHEREAS, Motorola was selected by BSO as the most qualified and responsible bidder and was awarded the bid; and

WHEREAS, Motorola and BOS entered into an Agreement on March 13th, 2020; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the City of Hialeah Code of Ordinances Section 2-818, if advantageous to the City, the City may utilize bids that have been awarded or under contract by other governmental agencies, in which case competitive bidding will not be required; and

WHEREAS, the specifications of the Bid No. 19053JLS, procured by BSO pursuant to a competitive process, are substantially similar to those required by the City; and

WHEREAS, Motorola has agreed to provide the City with hardware, software and installation services for Vigilant Automatic License Plate Readers, with CommandCentral Aware software integration, in an amount not to exceed \$488,301.89 for Fiscal Year 2020, plus \$191,658.48 for annual subscription and maintenance services for Fiscal Years 2021, 2022, 2023, 2024, for a total amount not to exceed \$679,960.37, pursuant to an Agreement, in a form acceptable to the City Attorney; and

WHEREAS, Motorola has made representations to the City, and the City has relied on Motorola's representations about its experience, equipment, manpower, capacity, permits and licenses to perform the services under the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it is in the best interest of the City to purchase the hardware and software from Motorola to allow comprehensive technology integration into law enforcement, ensuring that real time information is available to first responders, enhancing the ability to respond immediately and effectively to any crisis, while maximizing law enforcement's capability to protect the public's health, safety and welfare.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1: The foregoing facts and recitations contained in the preamble to this resolution are hereby incorporated and adopted by reference as if fully set forth herein.

Section 2: The City of Hialeah, Florida hereby approve the purchase of hardware, software and installation services for Vigilant Automatic License Plate Readers, with CommandCentral Aware software integration from Motorola Solutions, Inc. and service and

maintenance for a term of five years, in an amount not to exceed \$488,301.89 for Fiscal Year 2020, plus \$191,658.48 for annual subscription and maintenance services for Fiscal Years 2021, 2022, 2023, 2024, for a total amount not to exceed \$679,960.37, based on a competitively bid price and upon material terms and conditions substantially similar to Broward County Sheriff's Office Solicitation Bid No. 19053JLS, and authorizes the Mayor and the City Clerk, as attesting witness on behalf of the City, to execute an Agreement in a form acceptable to the City Attorney.

Section 3: This resolution shall become effective when approved by majority vote of the City Council and signed by the Mayor or at the next regularly scheduled City Council meeting, if the Mayor's signature is withheld or if the City Council overrides the Mayor's veto.




