

**RESOLUTION NO. 2021-032**

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE EXPENDITURE IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$32,000.00 FROM THE LAW ENFORCEMENT TRUST FUND-*STATE* FOR THE PURCHASE OF TWO (2) CANINES FOR THE HIALEAH POLICE DEPARTMENT CANINE UNIT FROM METRO DADE K-9 SERVICES, LOWEST QUOTED VENDOR, UPON SUCH COSTS HAVING BEEN APPROVED BY THE CHIEF OF POLICE, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS**, the Hialeah Police Department Canine Unit has a need for two (2) police canines to be used in the field as one (1) police canine with the Department has been retired and there is a need for additional canines; and

**WHEREAS**, canines are needed to physically apprehend subjects, detect explosives, assist conducting searches of explosive materials near building exteriors, parking lots, office areas, vehicles, packages and persons in and around public building facilities; and

**WHEREAS**, canines are needed to provide a strong visible and psychological deterrent against criminal and terrorist threats; and

**WHEREAS**, the Hialeah Police Department wishes to purchase two (2) canines from Metro-Dade K-9 services, the lowest quoted vendor; and

**WHEREAS**, Metro-Dade K-9 services is an active corporation in good standing in the state of Florida and licensed by the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF) and Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA); and

**WHEREAS**, funding for this project will be from account 105.1000.521.640 Law Enforcement Trust Fund-*State*; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 932.7055 of Florida Statutes, the Florida Contraband and Forfeiture Act, authorizes the expenditure of Law Enforcement Trust Funds-*State* for this purpose and the funds are available in the Law Enforcement Trust Fund-*State* account for the Police Department; and

**WHEREAS**, the Chief of Police of the Hialeah Police Department has recommended adoption of this resolution and determined that the proposed expenditure complies with the Florida Contraband Forfeiture Act, and all applicable rules, regulations and guidelines governing the expenditure of Law Enforcement Trust Fund-*State*; and

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**WHEREAS**, the City finds the expenditure is in the public interest;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

**Section 1:** The foregoing facts and recitations contained in the preamble to this resolution are hereby adopted and incorporated by reference as if fully set forth herein.

**Section 2:** The City of Hialeah, Florida hereby approves the expenditure of an amount not exceeding \$32,000.00 from the Law Enforcement Trust Fund-*State* for the purchase of two (2) canines from Metro-Dade K-9 Services, lowest quoted vendor, upon such costs having been approved by the Chief of Police of the Hialeah Police Department having specifications and pursuant to the terms and conditions as set forth in "Exhibit 1."




Dear Mayor Hernandez and Council Members:

The Charter of Hialeah states that contracts in amounts greater than \$15,000.00 shall be awarded on the basis of specifications and formal sealed bids. The Council may award a contract to the lowest responsible and responsive bidder, or it may reject all bids and re-advertise; or it may waive competitive bidding when it finds it to be the best interest of the City.

The Hialeah Police Department will be replacing a retired police canine and adding a second narcotics canine to the unit. One of the canines will be utilized for narcotics and explosives incidents while the second canine will be utilized for apprehensions. Explosives detection canines are critical for conducting searches for a variety of explosive materials near building exteriors, parking lots, office areas, vehicles, packages, and people in and around public building facilities. They also provide a strong visible and psychological deterrent against criminal and terrorist threats.

Metro Dade K-9 Services (17940 SW 168 Street Miami, Florida 33187) is the lowest quoted vendor and is in good standing in the state of Florida and is an active corporation.
