In 1968, when it passed the Fair Housing Act, Congress made a promise to the American people that it would end discrimination. The Act guarantees equal housing opportunities for all people and makes it illegal to discriminate based on race, color, national origin, gender, religion, family status, or disability.

April is Fair Housing Month and due to ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, our usual fair housing events and activities are canceled until further notice; however, the City of Hialeah wants to remind everyone that any allegations of fair housing violations will be fully investigated. The City also encourages everyone to be knowledgeable of their rights and protections under the Fair Housing Act.

During these unprecedented times, we ask all landlords, builders, apartment managers, real estate managers, and housing lenders take consideration and work with your renters and buyers.
