RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE EXPENDITURE TOTALING AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$112,400.00 FROM THE LAW ENFORCEMENT TRUST FUND -STATE, TO COVER AN INSTALLMENT PAYMENT DUE UNDER A PURCHASE EXECUTED WITH ORDER COMMUNICATION **SYSTEMS** LOGISTICS, INC., FOR THE REMOVAL AND DISPOSAL OF THE EXISTING HIALEAH POLICE DEPARTMENT AUTOMATED LICENSE PLATE READER SYSTEM AND THE ACQUISITION, INSTALLATION, AND CONFIGURATION OF A NEW AUTOMATED LICENSE PLATE READER SYSTEM, UPON SUCH COSTS HAVING BEEN APPROVED BY THE CHIEF OF POLICE.

WHEREAS, on June 13, 2017, the City Council authorized the issuance of a purchase order with Communication Systems & Logistics, Inc. for the removal and disposal of the existing automated license plate reader system and to purchase, install, and configure a new automated license plate reader system ("ALPR"); and

WHEREAS, the Hialeah Police Department seeks to make the September 2017 payment pursuant to the purchase order; and

WHEREAS, ALPR technology provides real-time analytical data that is valuable and effective in reducing, preventing and detecting crime; and

WHEREAS, the Hialeah Police Department Law Enforcement Trust Fund (LETF) funds may be spent in support of crime prevention, safe neighborhoods; drug abuse education and prevention programs, or for other law enforcement purposes; and

WHEREAS, the funds to cover these necessary and legitimate expenses are available in the Law Enforcement Trust Fund - State; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has recommended adoption of this resolution and determined that the proposed expenditure complies with Florida Statutes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1.
