

**RESOLUTION NO. 2016-02**

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA ACCEPTING A GRANT AWARD FROM THE STATE OF FLORIDA, DEPARTMENT OF LAW ENFORCEMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$20,892.00, THROUGH THE EDWARD BYRNE JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT, FOR FISCAL YEAR 2015-2016, TO FUND THE CITY'S DOMESTIC VIOLENCE PROGRAMS; AND FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE ON BEHALF OF THE CITY TO EXECUTE ALL NECESSARY DOCUMENTS IN FURTHERANCE THEREOF; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS**, the City of Hialeah is continuously searching for available grants to support special services for the community; and


**WHEREAS**, it is in the best interest and welfare of the community to accept this grant award to support the growth and development of the City's domestic violence programs, which provide assistance and services to families experiencing domestic violence within the community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

**Section 1:** The City of Hialeah, Florida hereby accepts a grant award from the State of Florida, Department of Law Enforcement in the amount of \$20,892.00, through the Edward Byrne Justice Assistance Grant, for fiscal year 2015-2016, to provide funding for the City's domestic violence programs, and further authorizing the Mayor or his designee on behalf of the City to execute all necessary documents in furtherance of this resolution. All action taken to date by officers of the City in furtherance hereof is hereby approved, confirmed and ratified.






