

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-017

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA APPOINTING VIVIAN CASÁLS-MUÑOZ AS ACTING COUNCILMEMBER TO FILL THE PERMANENT VACANCY ON THE HIALEAH CITY COUNCIL RESULTING FROM THE RESIGNATION OF COUNCILMEMBER OSCAR DE LA ROSA; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on January 26, 2022, former Councilmember Oscar De La Rosa resigned as a councilmember of the City of Hialeah city council, and notified the City of Hialeah in writing accordingly; and

WHEREAS, having determined that Vivian Casáls-Muñoz is a qualified elector and as of the date of appointment satisfies the residency requirement; and

WHEREAS, on February 8, 2022, the Hialeah City Council, by an affirmative vote of at least four members, appointed Vivian Casáls-Muñoz to fill the permanent vacancy resulting from the resignation of former Councilmember Oscar De La Rosa;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1: Vivian Casáls-Muñoz is hereby appointed to fill the permanent vacancy on the Hialeah City Council resulting from the resignation of Councilmember Oscar De La Rosa, and, pursuant to Section 2.02(c)(1) of the Charter of the City of Hialeah, Florida, shall be known as acting councilmember and is empowered to exercise all authority of the office of councilmember and to perform all the duties and assume the responsibilities of that office for that portion of Councilmember Oscar De La Rosa's term that precedes the next regularly scheduled state general election.

Section 2: This resolution shall become effective when passed by the City Council and signed by the Mayor or at the next regularly scheduled City Council

meeting, if the Mayor's signature is withheld or if the City Council overrides the Mayor's veto.






