

**RESOLUTION NO. 2016-105**

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, APPROVING A MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT WITH FLORIDA POWER TECHNOLOGIES, INC., FOR THE INSTALLATION, INSPECTION, AND MAINTENANCE OF BATTERIES, TECHNICAL SUPPORT AND INCIDENTAL BATTERY AND PARTS REPLACEMENT, FOR A TERM COMMENCING ON OCTOBER 1, 2016 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2017, IN AN ANNUAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$64,503.00, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE CITY CLERK, AS ATTESTING WITNESS, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY, TO EXECUTE THE SERVICES AGREEMENT ATTACHED HERETO AND MADE A PART HEREOF AS EXHIBIT "1".

**WHEREAS**, Florida Power Technologies, Inc. installs, maintains, and replaces batteries, hardware and connections, provides customer support including parts, 24-hour labor, travel and freight, all services integral to our power supply system; and


**WHEREAS**, the City finds it is in the best interest, health and welfare of the community to contract with Florida Power Technologies, Inc. to continue providing maintenance and support services to the City's power supply system.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

**Section 1:** The City of Hialeah, Florida hereby approves a maintenance agreement with Florida Power Technologies, Inc., a Florida corporation, for the installation, inspection, and maintenance of batteries, technical support and incidental battery and parts replacement, in an annual amount not to exceed \$64,503.00, for a term commencing on October 1, 2016 through

September 30, 2017, and authorizes the Mayor and the City Clerk, as attesting witness, on behalf of the City, to execute the services agreement attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit "1".




