RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, APPOINTING **MARIA M. NEGRON GONZALES** TO THE VETERAN'S AFFAIRS BOARD OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH FOR A (2)-YEAR TERM ENDING ON FEBRUARY 23, 2024.

WHEREAS, the City of Hialeah Veteran's Affairs Board is vested with the powers and duties of advising the City Council on significant and pertinent matters relating to veterans, promoting and encouraging public participation in activities honoring veterans, educating the public in the importance and value of military service to the United States, and advising the City Council on the recognition of veterans who received special honor in service to the United States and of veterans who lost their lives in service.

WHEREAS, the Veteran's Affairs Board shall consist of eight members.


WHEREAS, each Councilmember and the Mayor shall select a member.

WHEREAS, the term of office for each member shall be two years.

Section 1: Maria M. Negron Gonzales is hereby appointed to the Veteran's Affairs Board of the City of Hialeah, Florida, for a two (2)-year term ending on February 23, 2024.






