

RESOLUTION NO. 2021-162

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, APPROVING A SPECIFIC APPROPRIATION PURSUANT TO HIALEAH, FLA. CHARTER SECTION 3.08(d) IN THE AMOUNT OF \$115,603.00 FROM THE GENERAL FUND GENERAL GOVERNMENT CAPITAL OUTLAY EQUIPMENT ACCOUNT NO. 001.8500.519.640 TO THE GENERAL FUND MILANDER CENTER CAPITAL OUTLAY BUILDING ACCOUNT NO. 001.3140.572.620 TO FUND THE MILANDER CENTER EXTERIOR ROOFTOP TERRACE AND STAIRS-WATERPROOFING PURSUANT TO INVITATION TO BID NO: 2020-21-3230-00-028; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Hialeah Charter 3.08(d) allows the City Council, upon request of the Mayor and within the last 6 months of the fiscal year, to any unencumbered appropriation balance or portion thereof from one office or department to another, by resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1: The City of Hialeah, Florida, hereby approves a specific appropriation pursuant to Hialeah, Fla. Charter Section 3.08(d) in the amount of \$115,603.00 from the General Fund General Government Capital Outlay-Equipment Account no. 001.8500.519.640 to General Fund Milander Center Capital Outlay- Building Account no. 001.3140.574.620 to fund Milander Center Exterior Rooftop Terrace and Stairs-Waterproofing pursuant to Invitation to Bid no: 2020-21-3230-00-028.

Section 2: This resolution shall become effective when passed by the City Council of the City of Hialeah, Florida and signed by the Mayor of the City of Hialeah, Florida or at the next regularly scheduled City Council meeting, if the Mayor's signature is withheld or if the City

Council overrides the Mayor's veto.


