

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-051

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE ROMAN O. GARCIA, JR., TO SUBMIT GRANT APPLICATIONS ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, SUBJECT TO RATIFICATION BY CITY COUNCIL, UPON GRANT APPROVAL; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, a municipal government, the City of Hialeah is continuously searching and receiving notifications for funding availability which are time sensitive and may require immediate action; and

WHEREAS, due to time constraints it is not always possible to have City Council approval prior to the deadline for submission of the grant applications, which may potentially jeopardize available funding; and

WHEREAS, the acceptance and expenditure of all grants require official approval from the applicant's governing board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1: The Mayor or his designee, namely Roman O. Garcia Jr., is hereby authorized on behalf of the City of Hialeah to submit grant applications on behalf of the City of Hialeah in the discretion of the Mayor, subject to ratification by City Council.

Section 2: The Mayor or his designee is further authorized to make any and all necessary certifications and assurances in furtherance of any grant application made subject to ratification by City Council and final grant acceptance by the Council.

Section 3: This resolution shall become effective when passed by the City Council and signed by the Mayor or at the next regularly scheduled City Council meeting, if the Mayor's signature is withheld or if the City Council overrides the Mayor's veto.




