



CITY OF HIALEAH NOTICE OF MUNICIPAL ELECTION

SPECIAL PRIMARY ELECTION: NOVEMBER 8, 2022

SPECIAL GENERAL ELECTION, if necessary: DECEMBER 6, 2022

Pursuant to Ordinance No. 2022-020, adopted on March 22, 2022 by the City Council of the City of Hialeah, Florida, and in accordance with Florida Statutes, notice is hereby given of a **Special Primary Election** to be held in the City of Hialeah on **Tuesday, November 8, 2022**, in order to elect a Councilmember to fill a vacancy for City Councilmember Group IV. Furthermore, notice is hereby given of a **Special General Election (Run-Off Election)** to be held in the City of Hialeah on **Tuesday, December 6, 2022, if necessary**. Polls will open at 7:00 a.m., and will close at 7:00 p.m. All qualified electors of the City of Hialeah are eligible to cast their vote.

Individuals may announce their candidacy by obtaining a packet from the Office of the City Clerk, located at 501 Palm Avenue, Hialeah, Florida, third floor, and filing the appropriate forms. The forms necessary to qualify for the Offices of Mayor and City Council are also available on the City's website www.hialeahfl.gov and can be accessed using the following hyperlinks:

Candidates for Councilmember shall be electors of the City of Hialeah for one year prior to the Special Primary Election. Each person, before being eligible to have his or her name placed on the ballot, must qualify in person at the Office of the City Clerk no earlier than 12:00 p.m. noon on Monday, July 11, 2022, and no later than 5:00 p.m. on Monday, August 1, 2022, by submitting all required qualification papers with a filing fee of \$100.00 plus an election assessment pursuant to Section 99.093(1) of the Florida Statutes.

The voting registration book closing date for the Special Primary Election is October 11, 2022, and the voting registration book closing date for the Special General Election is November 7, 2022.

The elections will be conducted in accordance with the applicable provisions of the Florida Statutes, as they relate to Primary and General Elections, as well as the Charter and Code of the City of Hialeah.
