RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA REPEALING AND RESCINDING HIALEAH, FLA., RESOLUTION 95-81 (JUN. 27, 1995).

WHEREAS, having adopted Hialeah, Fla., Ordinance 13-83 (Dec. 2, 2013), which prohibits the naming of City properties after elected officials or relatives during the lifetime of elected officials, the City Council has reexamined the naming of existing properties in light of the new change to the Hialeah Code; and


WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the portion of West 4th Avenue, lying just East of State Road 823, also known as Red Road/West 4th Avenue, between West 47th Street and West 49th Street, in Hialeah, Florida, should not retain its current name.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1: The findings and recitations contained in preamble to this resolution are hereby incorporated by reference as if fully set forth herein.

Section 2: The City Council of Hialeah, Florida hereby repeals and rescinds Hialeah, Fla., Resolution 95-81 (Jun. 27, 1995) in its entirety.




WHEREAS, having adopted Hialeah, Fla., Ordinance 13-83 (Dec. 2, 2013), which prohibits the naming of City properties after elected officials or relatives during the lifetime of elected officials, the Hialeah Historic Preservation Board has reexamined the naming of existing properties in light of the change to the Hialeah Code; and

WHEREAS, the Historic Preservation Board recommends that the portion of West 4th Avenue, lying just East of State Road 823, also known as Red Road/West 4th Avenue, between West 47th Street and West 49th Street, in Hialeah, Florida, not retain its current name and that Hialeah, Fla., Resolution 95-81 (Jun. 27, 1995), be repealed and rescinded in its entirety.

Section 1. The Hialeah Historic Preservation Board recommends that the Hialeah, Fla., Resolution 95-81 (Jun. 27, 1995) be repealed and rescinded in its entirety.
