

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-080

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, IN RECOGNITION OF THE SIGNIFICANCE OF NATIONAL CUSTOM AND TRADITION OF THE AMERICAN FLAG, THAT ALL AMERICAN FLAGS PURCHASED TO BE FLOWN ON CITY PROPERTY SHALL BE MANUFACTURED AND PRODUCED IN THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA AND THEIR SIZE, DISPLAY, AND PRESENTATION SHALL, TO THE GREATEST EXTENT POSSIBLE, CONFORM TO THE FEDERAL FLAG CODE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the ultimate symbol of freedom, the American Flag represents hope, opportunity, dignity, and the true meaning of being an American; and

WHEREAS, Florida State law requires that all flags purchased for public use be made in the United States; and

WHEREAS, such a symbol of American patriotism should be manufactured and produced in the United States by our own citizens; and

WHEREAS, the production and manufacturing of American flags made in the United States supports our local and national economy creating jobs for families all across the Country; and

WHEREAS, an American flag “Made in the U.S.A” guarantees a quality product and fair working conditions for our American workers; and

WHEREAS, production of American flags in the United States keeps the American tradition of craftsmanship alive and creates an independent, self-sufficient nation which does not depend on other countries for the production of goods; and

WHEREAS, such a revered, patriotic symbol should be presented and displayed with the upmost decorum representative of our traditions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:


Section 1: The foregoing facts and recitations contained in the preamble to this resolution are hereby adopted and incorporated by reference as if fully set forth herein.

Section 2: All American flags purchased to be flown on City property be manufactured and produced in the United States of America.

Section 3: The presentation and display of all American flags flown on City property shall, to the greatest extent possible, conform with the Federal Flag Code.

Section 4: This resolution shall become effective when approved by majority of the City Council and signed by the Mayor or at the next regularly scheduled City Council meeting, if the Mayor's signature is withheld or if the City Council overrides the Mayor's veto.




