

**ORDINANCE NO. 2022-050**

ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, AMENDING CITY OF HIALEAH ORDINANCE NO. 2022-020 (MARCH 22, 2022), TO CORRECT THE LAST DATE THAT THE MIAMI-DADE COUNTY SUPERVISOR OF ELECTIONS WILL REGISTER VOTERS FOR THE CITY OF HIALEAH SPECIAL PRIMARY ELECTION OF NOVEMBER 8, 2022.

**WHEREAS**, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 2022-020 on March 22, 2022; and

**WHEREAS**, Miami-Dade County Department of Elections registers all persons eligible to vote at an election until 5:00 p.m. on the twenty-ninth day prior to the upcoming election.

**WHEREAS**, when the twenty-ninth day prior to voter registration closing date falls on a holiday, the voter registration closing date is changed to the next business day.

**WHEREAS**, the twenty-ninth day prior to the November 8, 2022 City of Hialeah Special Primary Election is October 10, 2022, observed as Columbus Day.

**WHEREAS**, since October 10, 2022 is a holiday, the Miami-Dade County Department of Election will register all persons eligible to vote in the November 8, 2022 City of Hialeah Special Election until 5:00 p.m. on October 11, 2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

**Section 1:** Ordinance No. 2022-020 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 7 – Registration of Voters. The Miami-Dade County Supervisor of Elections will register voters for the Special Primary Election until 5:00 p.m. on ~~Monday, October 10, 2022~~ Tuesday, October 11, 2022 and for the Special General Election until 5:00 p.m. on November 7, 2022. All persons eligible to vote at these elections must be registered before the times stipulated above or have registered previously, as provided by law.

**Section 2:** **Repeal of Ordinances in Conflict.**

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.


**Section 3: Severability Clause.**

If any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this ordinance shall be declared invalid or unconstitutional by the judgment or decree of a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs or sections of this ordinance.

**Section 4: Effective Date.**






