RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH RE-NAMING TRIANGLE PARK, LOCATED AT 290 PALM AVENUE TO "VETERAN'S PARK" IN HONOR OF THE MEN AND WOMEN WHO SERVE OR HAVE SERVED IN THE UNITED STATES ARMED FORCES, WITH THE COST OF SIGNAGE TO BE PAID BY THE CITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, roughly 18 million living American's have served in the United States Armed Forces in conflicts ranging from the World Wars to the War on Terror; and

WHEREAS, veterans fight to protect and defend freedom and democracy when tyranny threatens the World; and

WHEREAS, the United States of America remains a beacon of light for opportunity and equality because of the men and women of the Armed Forces, living and passed, who have dedicated their lives to protect the freedoms that make this country the greatest country in the World.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1: Triangle Park, located at 290 Palm Avenue, in the City of Hialeah, Florida is hereby renamed as "Veteran's Park", with the cost of signage to be paid by the City, in honor of the men and women who serve or have served in the armed forces.





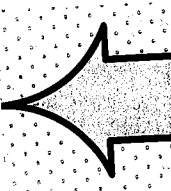
