RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH RE-NAMING SENATOR ROBERTO CASAS-VETERAN'S PARK, LOCATED AT 7900 WEST 32 AVENUE TO "SENATOR ROBERTO CASAS PARK" IN HONOR OF THE SENATOR'S PUBLIC SERVICE LEGACY, WITH THE COST OF SIGNAGE TO BE PAID BY THE CITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2022-026 was passed and adopted on February 22, 2022 renaming "Veteran's Park", located at 7900 West 32 Avenue, Hialeah, Florida to "Senator Roberto Casas-Veteran's Park"; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hialeah intends to rename "Triangle Park" to "Veteran's Park" to honor the men and women of the United States Armed Forces; and


WHEREAS, Senator Roberto Casas was Florida's first Cuban-American Republican State legislator and served as a City of Hialeah councilmember; and

WHEREAS, to honor Senator Casas for his exemplary leadership and dedication to public service, the Board has recommended renaming "Senator Roberto Casas-Veteran's Park" to solely bear the name of Senator Casas to "Senator Roberto Casas Park".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH THAT:




