

RESOLUTION NO. 2015-62

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA RATIFYING AND APPROVING SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS TO THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2014-2015 AND IN PARTICULAR, REVISING THE BUDGET TO SUPPLEMENT REVENUES WITHIN THE GENERAL FUND; WITHIN SPECIAL REVENUE FUNDS IN PARTICULAR, CDBG FUND, EMERGENCY SOLUTIONS GRANT FUND, HOME FUND, PARK GRANT/IMPACT FEE FUND, POLICE GRANT FUND, SHIP FUND, CITT SURTAX FUND, 21 CENTURY GRANT FUND, 21 CENTURY GRANT S.T.E.A.M. FUND, ECS AND LIBRARY GRANT FUND, AND WITHIN CAPITAL FUND, IN PARTICULAR EMERGENCY OPERATION CENTER FUND, PARKS PROJECTS FUND, WITH CORRESPONDING BALANCED EXPENDITURES, IN THE AMOUNTS LISTED IN EXHIBIT "1A".

WHEREAS, Hialeah Charter § 3.08(e)(1) allows the City Council, upon request of the Mayor, to make supplemental appropriations, by resolution, for the fiscal year if revenues exceed the estimated amount provided in the annual budget.

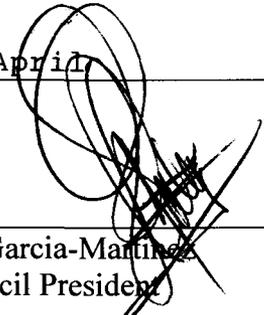
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1: The foregoing facts and recitations contained in the preamble to this resolution are hereby adopted and incorporated by reference as if fully set forth herein.

Section 2: The City of Hialeah, Florida hereby ratifies and approves the supplemental appropriations to the annual budget for fiscal year 2014-2015 and in particular, revising the budget to supplement revenues within the General Fund; within Special Revenue Funds in particular, CDBG Fund, Emergency Solutions Grant Fund, Home Fund, Park Grant/Impact Fee Fund, 21 Century Grant S.T.E.A.M. Fund, ECS and Library Grant Fund, and within Capital Fund, in particular Emergency Operation Center Fund, Park Project Fund, with corresponding

balanced expenditures, in the amounts listed in exhibit "1A", which is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

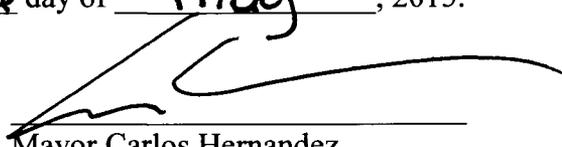

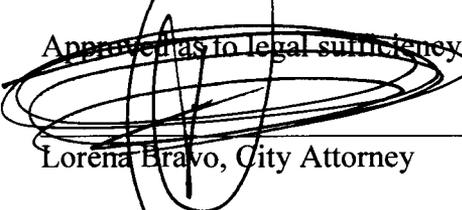
