WHEREAS, born and raised in Havana, Cuba, Efrain Camara (Sept. 10, 1933 – May 21, 2013) received a medical degree from the University of Havana at the age of 27; and

WHEREAS, after completing his internship and residency, Dr. Camara fled with his family from the Communist regime of Cuba, and relocated to Florida; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Camara resumed his residency in internal medicine, completed his fellowship in gastroenterology, and began his medical practice in Hialeah; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Camara practiced medicine in Hialeah for almost 40 years, rising through the ranks to attain prestigious appointments, such as Vice Chief of Medicine, Chairman of the Medical Care Review Committee, Chairman of the Gastroenterology Department and, ultimately, Chief of the Gastroenterology Department; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Camara was loved by his patients, colleagues, hospital staff, and anyone who had the opportunity to meet him; and


WHEREAS, Dr. Camara never turned away a patient, regardless of the patient's financial situation; and





RESOLUTION NO. 2015-02

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA REPEALING AND RESCINDING HIALEAH, FLA., RESOLUTION 95-81 (JUN. 27, 1995).

WHEREAS, having adopted Hialeah, Fla., Ordinance 13-83 (Dec. 2, 2013), which prohibits the naming of City properties after elected officials or relatives during the lifetime of elected officials, the City Council has reexamined the naming of existing properties in light of the new change to the Hialeah Code; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the portion of West 4th Avenue, lying just East of State Road 823, also known as Red Road/West 4th Avenue, between West 47th Street and West 49th Street, in Hialeah, Florida, should not retain its current name.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1: The findings and recitations contained in preamble to this resolution are hereby incorporated by reference as if fully set forth herein.

Section 2: The City Council of Hialeah, Florida hereby repeals and rescinds Hialeah, Fla., Resolution 95-81 (Jun. 27, 1995) in its entirety.




