

RESOLUTION NO. 2023-046

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, APPOINTING **ANTHONY J. GONZALEZ** AS A MEMBER OF THE BEAUTIFICATION COMMITTEE BEGINNING ON MAY 9, 2023, FOR A TWO (2)-YEAR TERM ENDING ON MAY 8, 2025.

WHEREAS, pursuant to City of Hialeah Ordinance No. 2022-075, the City established a beautification committee to recommend to the Mayor and City Council initiatives that will promote the beautification of the City;

WHEREAS, the Beautification Committee shall consist of five voting members, of which three (3) shall be City residents;

WHEREAS, nominations for members shall be considered by the City Council and the Mayor, and shall be selected as follows: one member appointed by the Mayor, and the remaining members by a majority vote of the City Council;

WHEREAS, members shall serve without compensation but may be reimbursed for necessary expenses incurred in official duties, as may be determined and approved by the City Council;


WHEREAS, members shall serve for a term of two years;

WHEREAS, Council President Perez has nominated Anthony J. Gonzalez, a non-resident elector of the City of Hialeah, for appointment to the City's Beautification Committee as one of the four members selected by the majority vote of the City Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1: Anthony J. Gonzalez is hereby appointed to the Beautification Committee of the City of Hialeah, Florida, for a (2)-year term ending on May 8, 2025.






