ENDING ON APRIL 30, 2022, WITH THREE YEAR FIVE **OPTIONS** RENEW TO PROVIDE, INSTALL AND MAINTAIN **BUS** PASSENGER **ADVERTISING** SHELTERS WITH DURING THE INITIAL TERM FOR MAXIMUM OF 100 **SHELTERS** IN SUBSTNATIAL **CONFORMITY** WITH THE TERMS OF LICENSE AGREEMENT ATTACHED AS **EXHIBIT** "1"; REPEALING ALL **ORDINANCES** OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION HEREOF; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Hialeah, Fla., Ordinance 02-27 (April 26, 2002), Clear Channel Outdoor, Inc entered into an exclusive license with the City of Hialeah to place, install and operate bus or transit passenger shelters located within the existing geographic limits of the City (not including the Annexation Area) for a term of 5 years, with two 5-year renewal options; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the license agreement, the City renewed the license with Clear Channel Outdoor, Inc. for an additional five years, ending on April 30, 2012; and again in 2012 for another five years; and

WHEREAS, Florida Statute, Section 337.408, allows for transit shelters and bus benches, including advertising displayed thereon to be installed within the rights of way of municipal, county or state roads, provided same are for the comfort or convenience of the general public at designated stops of official bus routes to a qualified provider under contract with the City.

WHEREAS, the parties have agreed to renew the license to include the annexation area provided in Exhibit "1".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1: The foregoing facts and recitations contained in the preamble to this ordinance are hereby adopted and incorporated by reference thereto as if fully set forth herein.

Section 2: The Mayor and the City Council of the City of Hialeah, Florida hereby grant a license to Clear Channel Outdoor, Inc. a Delaware corporation, for a term of five years, commencing on May 1, 2017 ending on April 30, 2022, with three five year options to renew, to provide, install and maintain bus passenger shelters with advertising under the terms and conditions of the License Agreement attached as Exhibit "1".

Section 3: Repeal of Ordinances in Conflict.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 4: Penalties.

Every person violating any provision of the Code or any ordinance, rule or regulation adopted or issued in pursuance thereof shall be assessed a civil penalty not to exceed \$500.00 within the discretion of the court or administrative tribunal having jurisdiction. Each act of violation and each day upon which any such violation shall occur shall constitute a separate offense. In addition to the penalty prescribed above, the City may pursue other remedies such as abatement of nuisance, injunctive relief, administrative adjudication and revocation of licenses or permits.

Section 5: Severability Clause.

If any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this ordinance shall be declared invalid or unconstitutional by the judgment or decree of a court of competent

jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs or sections of this ordinance.

Section 6: Effective Date.

This ordinance shall become effective when passed by the City Council and signed by the Mayor or at the next regularly scheduled City Council meeting, if the Mayor's signature is withheld or if the City Council overrides the Mayor's veto.

LICENSE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF HIALEAH AND CLEAR CHANNEL OUTDOOR, INC.

This License Agreement ("Agreement") entered into this	day of
, 2017, by and between the City of Hialeah, a municipal co	orporation
organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Florida	ι ("City"),

corporation ("Bus Passenger Shelter Company" or "Licensee"), having a	place of
business at 5800 NW 77 th Court, Miami, FL 33166.	

WHEREAS, the Bus Passenger Shelter Company, familiar with erecting, installing, maintaining and repairing bus passenger shelters with advertising up to a maximum of seventy-five (75) sites during the initial five-year term of the Agreement at sites approved by the City to be located along the public right-of-way within the City limits over which the City maintains control, and having expressed its desire and continued willingness to provide such services and having presented its qualifications to the City; and

WHEREAS, the City awarded a five-year license to the Bus Passenger Shelter Company with an option to renew for two successive five-year terms subject to mutual agreement of the City and the Bus Passenger Shelter Company; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Hialeah, Fla., Ordinance 02-27 (April 26, 2002), Bus Passenger Shelter Company entered into an exclusive license with the City of Hialeah to place, install and operate bus or transit passenger shelters located within the existing geographic limits of the City (not including the Annexation Area) for a term of 5 years, with two 5-year renewal options; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the license agreement, the City renewed the license with Bus Passenger Shelter Company for an additional five years, ending on April 30, 2012; and again in 2012 for another five years; and

WHEREAS, the City accepted the Bus Passenger Shelter Company renewals; and

WHEREAS, the City agrees to enter into this Agreement (including the Annexation Area) with the Bus Passenger Shelter Company and the Bus Passenger Shelter Company agrees to perform services under the terms and conditions set forth herein; and

WHEREAS, Florida Statute, Section 337.408, allows for transit shelters and bus benches, including advertising displayed thereon to be installed within the rights of way of municipal, county or state roads, provided same are for the comfort or convenience of the general public at designated stops of official bus routes to a qualified provider under contract with the City.

NOW, **THEREFORE**, in consideration of the mutual covenants and obligations herein contained and intending to be legally bound thereby, and subject to the terms and conditions hereinafter stated, the City and the Licensee enter into this License Agreement and agree as follows:

I. DURATION OF LICENSE AND OPTION TO RENEW

- A. Subject to all the terms and conditions contained in this License Agreement, and compliance with all applicable state, federal and local law, the City had granted Licensee permission to erect, install, maintain and repair bus passenger shelters with advertising at up to a maximum of seventy-five (75) sites during the initial five-year term of the first agreement at proposed and existing sites selected by the Licensee and approved by the City located along the public right-of-way within the City limits over which the City maintained control and other related services, and the City hereby grants Licensee for another period of five years commencing on May 1, 2017 with an option to renew for three successive five-year terms as provided by paragraph IB below, ending on April 30, 2037.
- B. The Licensee shall notify the City in writing within 180 days of the expiration of the initial five-year term or within 180 days of the expiration of the first renewal period, if applicable, of its intention to renew for a successive five-year term. If the Licensee is in compliance with the terms and conditions of this agreement, including payment provisions, the City shall approve the renewal of this Agreement. If the Licensee is in default or a request for renewal is not timely, the City, in its sole discretion, may deny the renewal of this Agreement.

II. SCOPE OF SERVICES

The Bus Passenger Shelter Company shall continue to:

A. Provide, install and maintain, at no cost to the City, attractive, clean and safe bus passenger shelters (that are constructed with a roof) with advertising of at least a minimum of 50 new or replacement shelters up to a maximum of one hundred (100) sites

during as selected by Licensee with the consent of the City to be located along the public right-of-way within the City limits over which the City maintains control; provided, however, the Licensee has and obtains the necessary permits and approvals prior to installation.

- 1. The maximum of one-hundred (100) bus passenger shelter sites may increase if there is good cause based upon sufficient commercial reasons. The Licensee shall cooperate with the City to place shelters along the Hialeah Transit System, the local shelter circulator.
- 2. The bus passenger shelters are the property of the Bus Passenger Shelter Company and shall be removed by the Bus Passenger Shelter Company within thirty days after termination of this Agreement or any extensions thereof, or upon request by the City. The Bus Passenger Shelter Company shall be responsible to restore the sidewalks, walkways and curbs that existed prior to the installation of the bus passenger shelters or benches.
- 3. Nothing contained in this Agreement shall be construed as creating an ownership interest in the Bus Passenger Shelter Company with respect to any sidewalks, walkways, curbs, or other public property to which the bus passenger shelters are temporarily attached.
- 4. Nothing contained in this Agreement shall be construed as creating any obligation on the part of the Licensee regarding a particular site or location if the Licensee is unable to reasonably obtain the necessary permits, approvals and authorizations.
- B. Provide site maintenance to the Licensee's shelters in the City and insure that the shelters are in a good state of repair and appearance.
 - 1. The Bus Passenger Shelter Company will provide, at its expense, a toll free phone number indicated on each shelter for maintenance and repair services, to be performed within twenty-four hours after notice. The number shall be operational seven days a week, twenty-four hours a day;
 - 2. The Bus Passenger Shelter Company shall be responsible for maintaining and cleaning ten feet away from each side of the bus passenger shelter. The Bus Passenger Shelter Company shall not allow these areas to be overgrown with grass or weeds or littered with garbage or debris. In addition, the Bus Passenger Shelter Company shall insure that each shelter

is free of graffiti, garbage, debris, other rubbish, rodents, insects and foul odors;

- 3. If a shelter is not maintained in good repair and in clean condition as determined by the City, the City shall notify the Licensee in writing. The Bus Passenger Shelter Company shall correct the condition within twenty-four hours after receipt of the City's notification. If the Bus Passenger Shelter Company fails to make the necessary repairs or clean up the area after notification from the City, the City may make the necessary repairs or clean up the area within such twenty-four hours of notice and the Bus Passenger Shelter Company shall be responsible for the City's costs, including, but not limited to, labor, overtime, materials, department overhead, equipment charges and any outside fees or costs incurred by the City.
- C. The Licensee shall have the right to sell advertising on its bus passenger shelters. The City shall have the right to require the Bus Passenger Shelter Company to remove any advertising material that the City in its sole discretion believes to be offensive, not suitable or aesthetically offensive to the City.
- D. The Bus Passenger Shelter Company shall make available to the City all unsold advertising space on the shelters for City sponsored advertising. The Licensee shall install all City sponsored advertising on the shelters at no cost to the City.

III. LICENSING FEE AND COMPENSATION

A. Payments shall be made quarterly based on prior three-month period. The Bus Passenger Shelter Company shall pay a yearly license fee for *each shelter* subject to renewal options. During the first year of the Agreement, one thousand five hundred sixty-nine dollars and thirty-one cents (\$1,569.31); during the second year of the Agreement, one thousand six hundred twenty-eight dollars and fifteen cents (\$1,628.15); during the third year of the Agreement, one thousand six hundred eighty-nine dollars and twenty cents (\$1,689.20); during the fourth year of the Agreement one thousand seven hundred fifty-two dollars and fifty-four cents (\$1,752.54); during the fifth year of the Agreement, one thousand eight hundred eighteen dollars and twenty-six cents (\$1,818.26); during the sixth year of the Agreement, one thousand eight hundred eighty-six dollars and forty-four cents (\$1,886.44); during the seventh year of the Agreement, one thousand nine hundred fifty-seven dollars and eighteen cents (\$1,957.18); during the eighth year of the Agreement, two thousand one hundred six dollars and seventy-one cents (\$2,106.71); during the tenth year of the Agreement, two

thousand one hundred eighty-five dollars and seventy-one cents (\$2,185.71); during the eleventh year of the Agreement, two thousand two hundred sixty-seven dollars and sixty-seven cents (\$2,267.00); during the twelfth year of the Agreement, two thousand three hundred fifty-two dollars and one cent (\$2,352.01); during the thirteenth year of the Agreement, two thousand four hundred forty dollars and twenty-one cents (\$2,440.21); during the fourteenth year of the Agreement two thousand five hundred thirty-one dollars and seventy-one cents (\$2,531.71); during the fifteenth year of the Agreement two thousand six hundred twenty-six dollars and sixty-four cents (\$2,626.64); during the sixteenth year of the Agreement two thousand seven hundred thirty-one and seventy cents (\$2,731.70); during the seventeenth year of the Agreement two thousand eight hundred forty dollars and ninety-six cents (2,840.96); during the eighteenth year two thousand nine hundred fifty-four Dollars and fifty-nine cents (\$2,954.59); during the nineteenth year of the Agreement three thousand seventy-two dollars and seventy-seven cents (3,072.77); and during the twentieth year three thousand one hundred ninety-five dollars and sixty-eight cents (\$3,195.68).

- B. The Bus Passenger Shelter Company may install or convert two-sided bus passenger shelters at the locations attached as Exhibit "A", and shall obtain variances, permits, and licenses, as may be required, to install same, as follows:
 - 1. Only 1 panel will be converted to LED.
 - 2. Each LED display shall provide a total of 8 spots, of which, 1 spot is reserved to the City for its use.
 - 3. Once converted to LED, the City shall continue to be paid 50 % of the guaranteed fee for the shelter, and 20 % of net advertising spots provided on the 7 LED spots.

IV. COMPLIANCE WITH FEDERAL, STATE AND LOCAL LAWS

The Bus Passenger Shelter Company shall comply with all applicable laws, ordinances, codes, rules and regulations of federal, state and local governments, including the City.

V. GENERAL CONDITIONS

All notices or other communications which shall or may be given pursuant to this Agreement shall be in writing and shall be delivered by personal service, or by registered mail addressed to the other party at the address indicated herein or as the same may be changed from time to time. Such notice shall be deemed given on the day on which

personally served; or if by mail, on the fifth day after being posted or the date of actual receipt, whichever is earlier.

VI. NONDELEGABLE

The duties and obligations undertaken by the Bus Passenger Shelter Company pursuant to this Agreement shall not be delegated or assigned to any person or firm. Any sale, transfer, assignment or other disposition of any license or duties and obligations undertaken hereunder, exclusive of construction and removal, shall be approved by the Hialeah City Council and the Mayor, by resolution, prior to continuation of any duties and obligations provided under this License Agreement.

VII. AWARD OF AGREEMENT

The Bus Passenger Shelter Company warrants that it has not employed or retained any person employed by the City to solicit or secure this Agreement and that it has not offered to pay, paid, or agreed to pay any person employed by the City any fee, commission, percentage, brokerage fee, or gift of any kind contingent upon or resulting from the award of this Agreement.

VIII. CONSTRUCTION OF AGREEMENT

This Agreement shall be construed and enforced according to the laws of the State of Florida. Venue for any litigation, which may arise in connection with this Agreement, shall be in Miami-Dade County, Florida. The Bus Passenger Shelter Company agrees to be subject to the jurisdiction (subject matter and *in personam*) of the courts in Miami-Dade County, Florida and amenable to process.

IX. SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS

This Agreement shall be binding upon the parties herein, their heirs, executors, legal representatives, successors and assigns.

X. INDEMNIFICATION

The Bus Passenger Shelter Company agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the State, City, its elected and appointed officials, officers, agents, servants, employees and their successors and assigns (all of whom constitute the indemnified parties), from and against any and all claims, demands, causes of action of whatsoever kind and nature, except to the extent caused by the negligence or intentional acts or omissions of the indemnified parties, sustained by the indemnified parties arising out of, by reason of, resulting from, or in connection with the Bus Passenger Shelter Company's performance of this Agreement and from and against any resulting losses, costs, expenses, reasonable attorney's fees incurred at trial or administrative proceedings and on appeal, liabilities, damages, orders, judgments or decrees.

XI. CONFLICT OF INTEREST

A. The Bus Passenger Shelter Company covenants that no person under its employ who presently exercises any functions or responsibilities on behalf of the City in connection with this Agreement has any personal financial interests, direct or indirect, with the Bus Passenger Shelter Company. The Bus Passenger Shelter Company further covenants that, in the performance of the Agreement, no person having such conflicting interest shall be employed. Any such interest on the part of the Bus Passenger Shelter Company or its employees must be disclosed in writing to the City.

B. The Bus Passenger Shelter Company is aware of the conflict of interest laws of the City, Hialeah Code ch, 26, Art. I and II, Miami-Dade County, Florida, Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida § 2-11.1, and the State of Florida, Chapter 112, Part III, Florida Statutes and agrees that it shall fully comply in all respects with the terms of said laws.

XII. INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR

The Bus Passenger Shelter Company, its employees, agents or representatives, shall be deemed to be independent contractors and not agents or employees of the City and shall not attain any rights or benefits under the civil service or pension ordinances of the City, or any rights generally afforded classified or unclassified employees. The Bus

Passenger Shelter Company, its employees, agents or representatives, shall not be entitled to Florida Workers' Compensation benefits as an employee of the City.

XIII. INSURANCE

- A. The Bus Passenger Shelter Company has maintained as provided in paragraph C, and shall provide, pay for and maintain, no later than ten (10) days after this Agreement is presented to the Licensee for signature, such insurance, including Workers' Compensation Insurance, Public Liability and Property Damage Insurance, Comprehensive General Liability Insurance, Contractual Liability Insurance, Automobile Liability Insurance and Owner's Protective Liability Insurance, which shall remain in force at all times during the services to be performed hereunder, and this Agreement. The Bus Passenger Shelter Company shall furnish, prior to execution of this Agreement by the City and issuance of the Notice to Proceed, Certificates of Insurance, which indicate that insurance coverage has been obtained for all required insurance policies. The Bus Passenger Shelter Company agrees to secure and pay the premiums for the following policies of insurance with the minimum insurance limits set forth below. Each such policy will be in the name of the Bus Passenger Shelter Company with the City named as an additional insured and shall cover all of the Licensee's operations covered in this Agreement.
- B. Such policies shall be issued by United States Treasury-approved companies authorized to do business in the State of Florida, and having agents upon whom service of process may be made in the State of Florida. The Bus Passenger Shelter Company shall specifically protect the City by naming the City as an additional insured under the Public Liability Insurance Policy, the Contractual Liability Insurance Policy, the Automobile Liability Insurance Policy and the Owner's Protective Liability Insurance Policy.
- C. All policies shall provide a notice of cancellation or restriction: The policies must be endorsed to provide City with at least 30 days notice of cancellation and/or restriction.
 - 1. Worker's Compensation Insurance as required by Chapter 440, Florida Statutes, and all applicable federal laws to apply for all of Licensee's employees.
 - 2. Public Liability Insurance on Comprehensive Basis in amounts not less than one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00) per occurrence for bodily injury and property damage combined with Completed Operations and Board Form property damage coverage included.

- 3. Contractual Liability Insurance covering all liability arising out of the terms of this Agreement.
- 4. Automobile Liability Insurance covering all owned, non-owned and hired vehicles used in connection with the work, in amounts not less than one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00) per occurrence for bodily injury and property damage combined.
- 5. Owner's Protective Liability Insurance issued in the name of the City as sole insured in amounts not less than one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00). This policy must be endorsed to indicate that any premium, whether deposit or final, will be the sole obligation of the Bus Passenger Shelter Company.
- 6. The Bus Passenger Shelter Company shall provide the City with a Certificate of Insurance or a copy of all insurance policies required in this article. The City reserves the right to require a certified copy of such policies upon request. All endorsements and certificates shall state that City shall be given at least 30 days' notice prior to expiration or cancellation of the policy.
- 7. Failure to maintain the insurance required above shall be just grounds for suspension or termination of this Agreement.
- D. The Bus Passenger Shelter Company agrees that the insurance coverage required shall include those classifications as are listed in standard liability insurance manuals, which most nearly reflect the operations of the Buss Passenger Shelter Company.
- E. All insurance policies required above shall be issued by companies authorized to do business under the laws of the State of Florida. The company must be rated no less than "A" as to management, and not less than Class "X" as to financial strength by the latest edition of Best's Insurance Guide, published by A.M. Best Company. Oldwick, New Jersey, or its equivalent, subject to the approval of the City's Risk Manager.
- F. The Bus Passenger Shelter Company agrees to furnish Certificates of Insurance to the City, subject to approval of the Risk Manager of the City, prior to the execution of this Agreement by the City and issuance of any Notice to Proceed and thereafter 30 days prior to the expiration dates of the policies, which Certificates shall clearly indicate that the Bus Passenger Shelter Company has obtained insurance naming the City as an additional insured of the type, amount and classifications as required for

strict compliance with this article and that no material change or cancellations of the insurance shall be effective without at least 30 days' prior written notice to the City. Certificates of Insurance must be sent to Robert Lloyd-Still, Risk Manager, City of Hialeah, 501 Palm Avenue, Third Floor, Hialeah, Florida 33010.

XIV. PERFORMANCE BOND AND LABOR AND MATERIAL PAYMENT BOND

A performance bond and labor and material payment bond may be required of the Bus Passenger Shelter Company. The Licensee executed, and shall duly execute and deliver, each year for the entire five (5) year term of this Agreement and any five-year extensions thereof, to the City a performance bond and a labor and material payment bond for improvements made. The performance bond and labor and materials payment bond shall be written through surety insurers authorized to do business in the State of Florida as surety.

XV. CASH BOND

A cash bond in the amount of \$10,000.00 to secure performance under the terms of this Agreement shall be furnished by the Bus Passenger Shelter Company to the City simultaneously with the submission of this Agreement by the Licensee. The cash bond will be deposited with the Finance Director of the City. The City shall keep any interest on the \$10,000.00 cash bond that accrues. The City will return to the Bus Passenger Shelter Company the \$10,000.00 cash bond but keep all interest accruing thereon, at such time that this agreement ends. An attorney trust account check, money order or cashier's check is acceptable for placing the cash bond.

XVI. NONDISCRIMINATION

The Bus Passenger Shelter Company agrees that it shall not discriminate as to race, color, creed, national origin, religion, age or disability in connection with its performance hereunder.

XVII. DEFAULT

A. Insolvency/Bankruptcy. Subject to paragraph C herein, Licensee shall be in default if during the terms of this Agreement,

1. Licensee:

a. files a voluntary petition in bankruptcy;

- b. is adjudicated insolvent;
- c. obtains an order for relief under Section 301 of the Bankruptcy Code (11 U.S.C. § 301);
- d. files any petition or fails to contest any petition filed against it seeking any reorganization, arrangement, composition, readjustment, liquidation, dissolution or similar relief for itself under any laws relating to bankruptcy, insolvency or other relief for debtors:
- e. seeks or consents to or acquiesces in the appointment of any trustee, receive, master, custodian or liquidator of Licensee, or any of Licensee's property and/or License and/or any and all of the revenues, issues, earnings, profits or income thereof;
- f. makes an assignment for the benefit of creditors;
- g. fails to pay Licensee's debts generally as they become due;
- h. conceals, removes or permits to be concealed or removed, any part of Licensee's property, with intent to hinder, delay or defraud Licensee's creditors or any of them, or makes or suffers a transfer of any of Licensee's property which may constitute an illegal preference or be considered an insider transaction, as defined in the Bankruptcy Code, or which may be fraudulent under any bankruptcy, fraudulent conveyance or similar law; or shall have suffered or permitted, while insolvent, any creditor to obtain a lien upon any of Licensee's property through legal proceedings which is not vacated within 30 days from the date thereof; or
- 2. A petition is filed in a court of competent jurisdiction against Licensee seeking any determination of bankruptcy, reorganization, arrangement, composition, readjustment, liquidation, dissolution or similar relief under any present or future federal or state statute, law or regulation relating to bankruptcy, insolvency or other relief for debtors, which petition is not vacated or dismissed within an aggregate or 90 days (whether or not consecutive) from the date of the filing thereof; or

- 3. Any trustee, receiver, custodian or liquidator of Licensee, or of any of the property of Licensee and/or of all or any party of this License and/or of any or all of the revenues, issues, earnings, profits or income therefrom, is appointed without the prior written consent of the City, which appointment shall remain unvacated and unstayed for an aggregate of 90 days (whether or not consecutive) from the date of the appointment; then upon the occurrence of any such events an Uncured Event of Default shall have occurred hereunder and the City may exercise any and all remedies available to it; or
- 4. Licensee fails to perform or observe any term, covenant, agreement or condition of this Agreement, on the part of Licensee to be performed within 30 days after prompt written notice thereof from the City, unless such performance shall reasonably require a longer period, in which case Licensee shall not be deemed in default if Licensee commences the required performance promptly and thereafter pursues and diligently completes such action.
- B. The City may terminate this Agreement for cause and cause shall include those events of default as provided in paragraph A above.
- C. Notice and Cure. Neither party shall be in default under this Agreement or in breach of any provision hereof unless and until the other party shall have given such party written notice of such default and the defaulting party shall have failed to cure the default within 30 days after receipt of such notice: provided, however, that where such default cannot reasonably be cured within such 30-day period, if the defaulting party shall proceed promptly to cure the same and prosecute such cure with due diligence, the time for curing such default shall be extended for such period of time as may be necessary under the circumstances.

XVIII. ENTIRE AGREEMENT

This Agreement and its attachments and exhibits constitute the sole and only agreement of the parties and accurately set forth the rights, duties, and obligations of each to the other. Any prior agreements, promises, negotiations, or representations not expressly set forth in this Agreement are of no force and effect.

XIX. AMENDMENT

No amendments to this Agreement shall be binding on either party unless in writing and signed by both parties.

XX. RIGHT TO REMOVE

The City and State of Florida may direct the immediate relocation or removal of any bus shelter that endangers life or property or that is otherwise not in compliance with applicable laws and rules, or which the City, in its reasonable judgment, does not believe conforms to the terms and conditions of this Agreement, or is no longer located for the public benefit. Additionally, as required by Florida Statues § 337.408, upon notice from either the City or State of Florida that the bus shelter installation is unreasonably interfering with the convenient, safe or continuous use of or the maintenance, improvement, extension or expansion of the road or right-of-way, Bus Passenger Shelter Company shall remove or relocate the bus shelter within sixty (60) days of such notice. Any such relocation or removal shall be at no cost to the City. Should Bus Passenger Shelter Company fail to remove such bus shelter promptly then the City shall have the right to remove the bus shelter at the expense of Bus Passenger Shelter Company and charge Bus Passenger Shelter Company accordingly.

XXI. MISCELLANEOUS

- A. Captions, title and paragraph headings are for convenient reference and are not a part of this Agreement. Such captions, title or paragraph headings shall not be deemed in any manner to modify, explain, enlarge or restrict any of the provisions contained in this Agreement.
- B. No waiver or breach of any provision of this Agreement shall constitute a waiver of any subsequent breach of the same or any other provision hereon, and no waiver shall be effective unless made in writing.
- C. Should any provisions, paragraph, sentence, work or phrase contained in this Agreement be determined by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, illegal or otherwise unenforceable under the laws of the State of Florida, such provisions, paragraphs, sentences, words or phrases shall be deemed modified to the extent necessary in order to conform with such laws, or if not modifiable to conform with such laws, then same shall be deemed severable, and in either event, the remaining terms and provisions of this Agreement shall remain unmodified and in full force and effect.
- D. Further Assurances. All parties hereto upon the request of any other party shall execute such further instruments or documents as may be reasonably required by the requesting party to implement the terms, conditions and provisions of this Agreement.

- E. Nothing in this Agreement shall be interpreted or construed to mean that the City waives its common law sovereign immunity or the limits of liability set forth in Section 768.28, Florida Statutes.
- F. Neither The Bus Passenger Shelter Company nor City intends to directly or substantially benefit a third party by this Agreement. Therefore, the parties agree that there are no third party beneficiaries to this Agreement and that no third party shall be entitled to assert a right or claim against either of them based upon this Agreement.
- G. The Bus Passenger Shelter Company represents that The Bus Passenger Shelter Company is duly organized and validly existing under the laws of the State of Delaware and properly and lawfully registers to do business with the State of Florida, with full legal right and authority to enter and perform its obligations under this Agreement, and is duly authorized to execute and deliver this Agreement without further approvals or authorizations.
- H. The Bus Passenger Shelter Company shall provide the City with a list of the bus passenger shelters installed to date, that shall become Exhibit "B" to this Agreement.
- I. The undersigned has authority to sign this Agreement, and bind Bus Shelter Company.
