

RESOLUTION NO.: 2014-64

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF LAW ENFORCEMENT TRUST FUNDS – STATE, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED TWELVE THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED AND EIGHTY EIGHT DOLLARS (\$12,688.00) TO SUPPORT THE 2014 HIALEAH POLICE CADET SUMMER WORK PROGRAM, UPON SUCH COSTS HAVING BEEN APPROVED BY THE CHIEF OF POLICE.

WHEREAS, the Hialeah Police Cadet Program is a diversionary program for at-risk, low-income family youths ages 14 through 18; and

WHEREAS, the Hialeah Police Department has sponsored a Summer Cadet Work Program for the last sixteen years; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the program is to prevent or reduce crime by establishing a rapport between law enforcement officers and disadvantaged youths, and to direct such youths away from committing crimes by otherwise occupying their time; and

WHEREAS, the Hialeah Police Department desires to sponsor twenty financially disadvantaged Cadets so they may participate in the Summer Cadet Work Program along with their fellow Cadets; and

WHEREAS, the Cadets would work five hours a day, four days a week at the rate of \$7.93 per hour, a rate in compliance with the guidelines of federal child labor laws; and

WHEREAS, the funds to cover these necessary and legitimate expenses are available in the Law Enforcement Trust Fund - State; and


WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has recommended adoption of this resolution and determined that the proposed expenditure complies with the Florida Contraband Forfeiture Act, Section 932.7055, *Florida Statutes*, (2013).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1. The Mayor and the City Council of the City of Hialeah, Florida, hereby

authorize the expenditure of Law Enforcement Trust Funds - *State*, in an amount not to exceed Twelve thousand six hundred and eighty eight dollars (\$12,688.00), to support the 2013 Hialeah Police Cadet Summer Work Program, upon such costs having been approved by the Chief of Police.




