

RESOLUTION NO.: 2014-04

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE EXPENDITURE TOTALING AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$3,000.00 FROM THE LAW ENFORCEMENT TRUST FUND – *STATE*, TO SPONSOR THE HIALEAH POLICE DEPARTMENT IN THE LEO FOUNDATION AWARDS DINNER, UPON SUCH COSTS HAVING BEEN APPROVED BY THE CHIEF OF POLICE.

WHEREAS, the Fourteenth Annual LEO Foundation LEO Awards Dinner is scheduled to be held in March of 2014; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hialeah shall be represented by members of the Hialeah Police Department as well as members of the Hialeah Police Department SWAT team;

WHEREAS, members of the Hialeah Police Department SWAT team have been nominated to receive the Officer of the Year Award in honor of the brave actions of the Hialeah Police Department during the tragic mass shooting and hostage rescue that occurred in Hialeah, Florida on July 26, 2013; and

WHEREAS, the funds needed to cover this necessary, appropriate, and legitimate expense are available in the Law Enforcement Trust Fund – *State*; and


WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has recommended adoption of this resolution and determined that the proposed expenditure complies with all applicable statutes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1. The Mayor and the City Council of the City of Hialeah, Florida, approve the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$3,000.00 from the Law Enforcement Trust Fund – *State*, for sponsorship of the LEO Foundation Awards Dinner, upon such costs

having been approved by the Chief of Police.


