RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, NAMING THE 72-UNIT ELDERLY **AFFORDABLE** HOUSING **APARTMENT** COMPLEX LOCATED AT 275 PALM AVENUE, HIALEAH, FLORIDA, "VILLA ALEGRIA," IN CELEBRATION OF THE **CURRENT** GENERATION OF **ELDERLY** HIALEAH RESIDENTS.

WHEREAS, the City recently completed the construction of an elderly housing project comprised of seventy-two residential units located at 275 Palm Avenue, Hialeah, Florida; and

WHEREAS, the word "alegria" is Spanish for "joy"; and

WHEREAS, the City has a large elderly population that is experiencing the joys of entering into their golden years; and

WHEREAS, in celebration of the City's current elderly generation, the City of Hialeah wishes to designate the elderly housing project "VILLA ALEGRIA"; and

WHEREAS, the Historic Preservation Board recommended approval of the naming of the elderly housing complex on October 2, 2013.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

<u>Section 1:</u> The 72-unit elderly housing facility located at 275 Palm Avenue, Hialeah, Florida, is hereby designated as "VILLA ALEGRIA," and shall be known as such from this day forward.
