

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE EXPENDITURE TOTALING AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$60,000.00 FROM THE LAW ENFORCEMENT TRUST FUND – *FEDERAL*, FOR THE RENTAL OF UNDERCOVER VEHICLES, FROM ENTERPRISE LEASING VENDOR #17908, UPON SUCH COSTS HAVING BEEN APPROVED BY THE CHIEF OF POLICE.

**WHEREAS**, the Hialeah Police Department investigates high level narcotic and other complex investigations that require surveillance of subjects and locations in various settings; and

**WHEREAS**, in an effort to properly conduct police department business and/or surveillance without detection it is necessary to avoid using vehicles that are associated with law enforcement; and

**WHEREAS**, having the ability to rent a variety of vehicles from different manufacturers will increase the likeliness of successful investigations without detection as well as maintain the safety of Hialeah Police Department personnel; and

**WHEREAS**, the funds to cover these necessary and legitimate expenses are available in the Law Enforcement Trust Fund - *Federal*; and

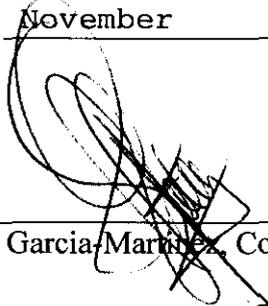
**WHEREAS**, the Chief of Police has recommended adoption of this resolution and determined that the proposed expenditure complies with *Guide To Equitable Sharing* and all applicable statutes; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

**Section 1.** The Mayor and the City Council of the City of Hialeah, Florida, approve the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$60,000.00 from the Law Enforcement

Trust Fund – *Federal*, for the rental of undercover vehicles from Enterprise Leasing Vendor #17908, upon such costs having been approved by the Chief of Police.
